Seating is limited and registration is required to reserve a place.

The Position

This is a responsible position with emphasis on the protection of life and property through enforcement of laws and ordinances; prevention and suppression of fire; rescue; and administration of emergency medical aid. Work is performed in accordance with standardized training and departmental policies, rules and regulations.

Requirements

- Candidate must hold at least a Basic Firefighter Certification OR be eligible for certification by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection.
- Must hold a current Texas Department of Health Services EMT, EMT-I, or EMT/P (paramedic preferred) Certificate.
- Must obtain a valid Class B Texas Driver's License within 6 months of employment date.

Ability to:

- Deal courteously with the public;
- Analyze situations and adopt a quick, effective and reasonable course of action;
- Act without direct supervision and exercise independent discretion in meeting emergencies;
- Have adequate physical strength and agility to perform arduous work, even under adverse weather and/or less than ideal conditions.
