FOREST HILL ASSISTED LIVING TO RISE IN THE CITY

A \$3.2 –million dollar healthcare facility is set to rise in the City of Forest Hill in Tarrant County, in the next 60 days. The facility is named FOREST HILL ASSISTED LIVING (formerly known as Fountains of Forest Hill) which is under the project development of Forest Hill Assisted Living Project based in Fort Worth, Texas.

The 75- bed facility will house a 25-bed wing dedicated to memory care residents, 10 private beds, 40 two-bed units, a spacious community hall, a full size commercial kitchen, a backyard patio, a physician office, a medication room, an activity area and a restaurant-style dining hall as well as ample parking spots for visitors. The center piece of the facility will be a fountain at the entrance lounge which will welcome the guests and family the “feel of serenity, peace and calmness” in the building.

Set to open in early 2012, the construction begins shortly by end of June 2011 with the project management and city officials expected to witness the ground breaking of the building construction.

The facility is located at the hilly corner of a major freeway, I-20 and California Parkway, overlooking the freeway in the south, the greenery forest in the north, and the residential area in the west.

Under the development of FHAL Project, LLC of Edgar M. Santiago, the Managing Director of the company, *“we are building a facility which will house the residents in a city where peace, harmony, calmness and the feel of security will be the center of their lives.”*

The first of its own kind of a healthcare care facility to be built in the city, Forest Hill Assisted Living aims to serve the city in multiple ways: create jobs for the city residents, launch a building as the city's premier aging health care facility and to serve as a hub of adult activities for retired and aging population.

Edgar M. Santiago is an entrepreneur from Dallas, Texas whose background in healthcare marketing is premised in serving the aging population. He has worked in several companies in the last 18 years, serving the seniors population in the Dallas-Fort worth areas - in a home health agency, in a hospice agency, in an assisted living, in a personal care facility and in an adult rehab facility.

Forest Hill Assisted Living will announce its vacancies in the next few months for various positions including CNAs, PCA (personal care assistants), office staff, and clinical care coordinator and medication assistants. The facility is expected to hire local residents to help build the facility's growth as the city's premiere assisted living.
