City Manager in Forest Hill Terminated

[Forest Hill, TX- December 1, 2009, 11:30pm] Four to two, City leaders in Forest Hill voted at tonight's City Council meeting to terminate City Manager David Miller. Council member Andrew Sanders had an excused absence.

Council member Dulani Masimini read the motion "I make a motion to terminate the City Manager and pay the severance amount based upon the contract if the City Manager agrees to execute a release, waiver and settlement in a form drafted by legal counsel and approved by this City Council." The motion was seconded by Council member Damian Dalcour.

After discussion and a closing statement by Mr. Miller, the vote was taken. Immediately after the vote, the Council made the decision, with one dissenting vote, to appoint City Secretary Debra Maness as Interim City Manager.
