



## What's my trash?

Not sure what you can place at the curb on normal trash days? Keep this list handy so you know what *can* and *can't* be thrown out on trash day!

### ACCEPTABLE:

- \*Bagged or containerized household garbage
- \*Bagged leaves or yard waste
- \*Bundled tree, shrub and brush trimmings securely tied in an easily handled package not exceeding four (4) feet in length and fifty (50) lbs in weight
- \*Bulky items including stoves, furniture, water heaters, dishwashers, etc.
- \*Federal Law prohibits the collection of refrigerator or freezer units unless certification is provided that CFC's have been removed by a certified technician.
- \*Construction and fencing materials generated by the homeowner resulting from repair and remodeling projects as long as the materials are containerized or tied in bundle's not to exceed four (4) feet in length and fifty (50) lbs. in weight

### NOT ACCEPTABLE:

- \*tires
- \*dead animals
- \*concrete
- \*empty containers which have been used for pesticides, herbicides, fungicides or rodenticides
- \*paint cans
- \*septic tank pumpings
- \*grease and grit trap wastes
