



The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) requires that cities providing water to populations of 3,000 or more monitor sites in their respective systems for lead and copper every three (3) years. In August, 2007, the required thirty (30) water samples were collected at designated sites and were sent to the TCEQ laboratory for testing.

The test results have been received from TCEQ and, as in previous testing years, the test results were good on all of the locations sampled. The levels of lead and copper tested to be below the levels allows by the State of Texas.
